Research Code of Conduct

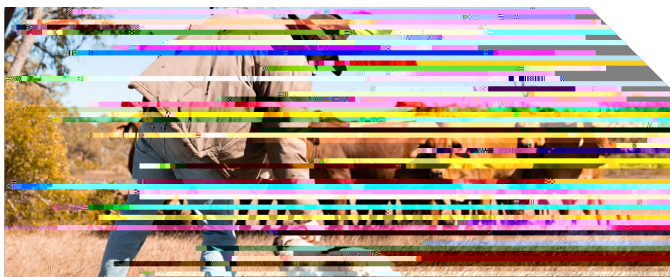
The Australian Code of Research Ethics provides the ethical framework for research involving humans. JCU has adopted the principles in the [Code of Research Ethics of Research](#). The code of ethics in research and human research:

- Manage breaches of the Code and allegation of research misconduct;
- Manage research data and materials;
- Publish and disseminate research findings, including publication of a hypothesis;
- Conduct research ethically;
- Manage conflicts of interest.

Your institutional Research Integrity Advisory Committee is responsible for the implementation of the Code.

Animal Welfare and Ethics

Animal welfare is a priority for all research involving animals. Research involving animals can only be conducted in compliance with the relevant legislation, including the



Research involving / will be conducted in an Aboriginal and Torres Strait Island community;

Take appropriate steps to ensure the safety of the research and Torres Strait Island people;

Recommendation of the research is likely to include a significant number of Aboriginal and Torres Strait Island people.

Clinical Trial

A clinical trial is a form of human research designed to find out the effects of an intervention, including a treatment or diagnostic procedure.

Clinical trial in Australia can only be conducted in accordance with the National Statement on Ethical Conduct in Human Research and the current Australian Government Therapeutic Goods Administration legislation. De-identification of the name of the trial, JCU or Health Service Director Human Research Ethics Committee will be required. Clinical trial may be registered in the publicly accessible database Australian New Zealand Clinical Trial Register.
